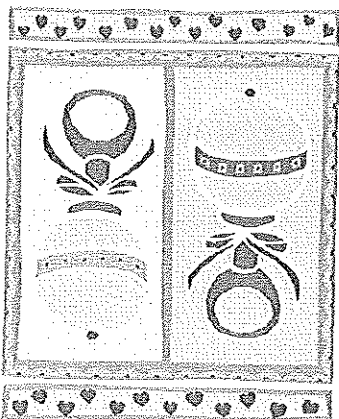
ways smiling. Ben is our newest infant and he is just adorable.

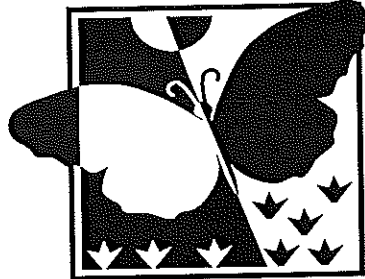

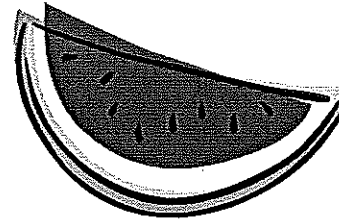


## Preschool News
